Re: Regional Waste Disposal Site, Burlington
Your file No. A-210102

Your letter of May 31, 1976 which accompanied the most recent site inspection report of the Burlington site pointed out the problem of illegal dumping at the entrance to the site.

Several measures have been tried without success to reduce or eliminate this problem. The refuse has been searched in an attempt to find those responsible; the Regional Police patrolled the North Service Road periodically on the lookout for offenders; several increasingly larger containers were placed at the entrance, but could not cope with the volume, and an attendant was posted at the site in an attempt to control the dumping.

The Public Works Committee has suggested that a small area outside the gate be provided for disposal 24 hours a day, 7 days per week to facilitate those who now dump illegally.

It would be appreciated if your comments on this suggestion be forwarded to us by letter for the next Public Works Committee meeting on June 23, 1976.
