Dear Sir:

Some time ago you contacted our office with a view to incorporating SEAP and to ask us whether we would do it.

We are a public interest group and designed to provide legal assistance to those who cannot afford the private Bar. After our conversation, I am sure that your organization will qualify for our help and we will be able to file the papers on your behalf on receipt of your instructions.

I shall point out however, that the provincial filing fee is \$125.00 and this we cannot pay on your behalf. Furthermore we need your specific instructions as to what you want the objects of the corporation to be and the names of directors, including their office addresses, their home addresses, and their citizenship. (In Ontario it is necessary to have a majority of the directors who are Canadian citizens.)

If you do become a corporation, you have certain duties to perform and we suggest that you invest approximately \$70.00 in obtaining the proper books of accounting and corporate register and so forth.

Please let me hear from you at your convenience.
