Pat Lawson from Port Hope called today to say that the town council in Newcastle has changed its mind and is now welcoming El Dorado's expansion. Newcastle looked into the possibility of an injunction to prevent receiving hot fill dumping but the lawyer for Newcastle for the AECB and for El Dorado told them that they had no jurisdiction and that it was an entirely federal matter.

So, since they decided that they had to accept the fill at Port Granby, they might as well take the goodies of the \$50,000,000 expansion. El Dorado now owns 600 acres adjoining the dump which it wants developed.

Councillor, Kirt Entwhistle, apparently has been quoted as supporting El Dorado's application although very recently he said that he was against it.
