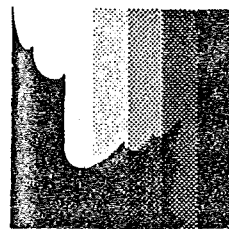

Re: Task Force on the Definition of a Hazardous Waste

Thank you for your letter of July 19, 1979, respecting the above matter.

I have reviewed your letter and attachments and in consultation with CELRF staff members and directors I am prepared to sit on the Task Force if the following conditions can be agreed to by your office:

- 1) Coverage by the Task Force or Environment Canada of all expenses including travel, accomodation, xeroxing, long-distance telephone calls, typing, etc. This can be either by way of letter of commitment or contract as appropriate.
- 2) An indication of what information will be made available to CELRF and an agreement that we can review and obtain additional information from government agencies (e.g. Environment Canada, Ontario Ministry of Environment) under the auspices of the Task Force where we deem it appropriate.
- 3) If we deem it necessary or appropriate, publication by the Task Force of a minority report with its main report.
- 4) That time spent by me on this project either in terms of preparation prior to or in attendance at meetings will be billable time under a contract to Environment Canada, at a consulting rate of \$20 per hour. Maximum time to be spent will be 100 hours for a total of \$2,000 over and above the expenses listed in term (1) above. If more than 100 hours of my time is spent the contract will be amended to reflect this additional time again at the rate of \$20 per hour.
- 5) That the Task Force also include a member with expertise on risk assessment who is not otherwise a member of industry or government.

I should be pleased to discuss the contents of this letter with you at your convenience.
