Enclosed please find a copy of U.S. EPA's press release and motion brought before Judge Curtin yesterday in chambers.

Amici have until December 17, 1981 to file a response.

It is clear that U.S. EPA's credibility and the Agreement has been severely undermined by this revelation. The 'presumption of agency expertise' that EPA argues has been put in question.

It may well be appropriate for John Roberts to write to the Court urging disapproval. As well, external should be taking a harder diplomatic line.

With no weight given to the U.S. government's sole hydrogeologist, Grant Anderson's evidence becomes even more compelling.
