Enclosed please find a copy of the 'body' of our amicus brief, a copy of our post-hearing submission to the Court, as well as a background story from the CELA newsletter on our involvement in this case.

As I mentioned, the Judge has still not decided whether to approve or disapprove the Settlement Agreement proposed by Hooker, U.S. EPA, and New York State. It is our position that the Judge must disapprove the Argument in its present form and that substantial modifications are required. (See post-hearing submission enclosed.)

We would urge the Anglican Church to write to Judge Curtin as soon as possible, calling on him to disapprove the proposed settlement agreement in its present form as being inadequate to prevent the continued migration of highly toxic chemicals into the Niagara River.
