Further to our letter dated October 10, 1984, regarding the Halton Environmental Assessment Study and our request for comments on the Review and Supplement to Stage 2B Draft Report, I am advising you that Regional Council met on December 5, 1984, and adopted the Review and Supplement to Stage 2B Selection of Candidate Sites Final Report, November 1984, and the Submissions Report Review and Supplement to Stage 2B November 1984 as prepared by Walker, Wright Young Associates.

The enclosed Submission Report, analyses the public comments received and provides the Consultant's response to each comment. The enclosed Final Report on the Review and Supplement to Stage 2B, contains an Executive Summary in the introduction for ease of understanding. Section 1 reviews the waste forecast, Section 2 reviews the single versus multi site approach, Section 3 reviews the site selection process and Section 4 provides a conclusion and recommendations. Appendix D compares the changes that were made between the Draft Report and Final Report as the result of the analyses of public comments received.

The Stage 2B Final Report is based on a revised long-term solid waste forecast requirement for increased landfill capacity for the twenty year planning period resulting from the Energy From Waste Study. All of Halton's solid waste for the twenty year planning period will now be landfilled for eight years (1988-1996) then fifty percent of the solid waste will go directly to an Energy From Waste Plant, and fifty percent, plus ash and residue and non-combustible materials will go to the landfill site for the remaining twelve years (1997-2008). The Final Report also reviews the evaluation factors, the site selection process at the Stage 2B level of detail and the single site versus multi site approach.

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The main conclusions from the report are summarized in the Executive Summary at the front of the Final Report.

Due to the additional time allowed for public review of the enclosed document, the Draft Stage 2C Report, comparing the six candidate sites and identifying a preferred landfill site, is scheduled to be available for public comment and review in mid-January, 1985.
