Re: Environmental Assessment for the Landfill Component of
Halton's Solid Waste Management System

The Consultants responsible for preparing the Environmental Assessment for the landfill component of Halton's Solid Waste Management System have completed their Draft Report on Phase 2, Stage 2B in which they selected six candidate sites which are considered environmentally, socially and economically suitable for further consideration for future landfill. To give you a better understanding of the process that has been used to choose the six candidate sites, we have included a brief description of the Environmental Assessment process for this project. A Draft Work Program for the final site(s) evaluation of the candidate sites is also included in this mailing, in order to provide you with a more complete appreciation of the next phase of work. Included in that document is a description of the opportunities for public participation in Stage 2C. A summary of their technical report on this work is enclosed.

Enclosed with this letter is a pre-stamped business reply card which you must return if you wish to remain on the mailing list for this project. If you do not return this card by Friday, March 30, 1984, we will assume you do not wish to continue to receive mailings about this project and your name will be removed from the mailing list. All you need to do to remain on the list is fill in your name and address and indicate whether you wish to receive the consultant's technical reports or a summary of the reports. (If you indicate a preference for the technical report, we will mail you a copy of the Draft Report on Stage 2B that was submitted to Council as soon as we receive your card). Three Public Information Centres will be held to enable you to review and comment on the process used by the Consultants in selecting the six candidate sites and to review and comment on the evaluation factors (Stage 2C) which will be used to select

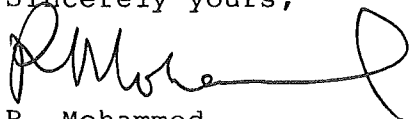
