Dear Ms. Vigod:

The Glen Abbey (Oakville) Residents' Association, Incorporated is a non-profit, fully incorporated organization, representing the 1,200 families in this community at this time. Within the next few years, our community is projected to grow to 22,000 people. The boundaries of Glen Abbey are the Sixteen Mile Creek on the East, the Queen Elizabeth Way on the South, the Bronte Escarpment on the West, and Upper Middle Road on the North. The Association relies for funds only on membership fees collected annually from our residents (\$5.00 per family).

Attached are:

- (1) a draft report of our concerns on a garbage incinerator (Energy from Waste) proposed to be built in the Parkway Belt adjacent to Glen Abbey's Western boundary. We are in the process of trying to get volunteer "experts" to help us in our submission to the Region of Halton so this list of concerns is not yet complete;
- (2) a letter prepared by Mr. Andrew Leeksma, an Environmental Engineer who is a member of our Association. This letter is a part of our submission and has not been mailed;
- (3) a copy of Mr. Perlin's most recent letter outlining the proposal; and,
- (4) a map of the Glen Abbey community on which is superimposed the location of the proposed plant.
