RE: Halton Landfill Study/Proposed Regional Official Plan
Amendments to Permit Sanitary Landfilling
File: SD13C

Since my last letter to you dated October 28, 1985, Halton's Landfill consultant, Walker Wright Young Associates Ltd., has prepared two Proposed Regional Official Plan Amendments to permit Sanitary Landfilling at:

- a) Site 'F' in the City of Burlington (enclosed as Regional Official Plan Amendment 12A), or
- b) Site 'D' in the Town of Milton (enclosed as Regional Official Plan Amendment 12B)

1. The Purpose of the Amendments

The purpose of these Planning Amendments is two-fold:

- a) to update the Solid Waste Management goals, objectives and policies contained within the Regional Official Plan, and
- b) to identify Sanitary Landfilling as a permitted use within the Halton Planning Area.

2. Public Meeting

The Planning and Public Works Committee will be holding a Public Meeting on the Proposed Regional Official Plan Amendments on Wednesday, February 12, 1986, at 9:30 a.m. in Committee Room 1 at the Regional Administration Building as shown on the map below. If you wish to be a delegation at this meeting, please notify the Clerk's department no later than Wednesday February 5, 1986.

3. Comments Due by March 14, 1986

Comments on the Proposed Regional Official Plan Amendments should be submitted to the Planning and Development Department on or before March 14, 1986.

4. Analysis of Public Comments

Walker Wright Young Associates Ltd. will analyze the comments received and make appropriate modifications to the Amendments. Halton staff will then report back to Council on the analysis of written and verbal comments received at the Public Meeting and on the revised Amendments.

On July 23, 1985, Regional Council adopted a program to proceed with further environmental planning and economic analysis of two sites with the environmental analysis to be undertaken at an even greater level of detail. The proposed Regional Official Plan Amendments are a result of further planning work. Walker Wright Young Associates will be doing a Comparative Analysis after completion of these final detailed studies and at that time, Council will be giving further consideration to the landfill site location.
