TWO CITIZENS GROUPS IN HALTON GRANTED \$30,000 IN INTERVENOR FUNDING BY ENVIRONMENT MINISTRY

Two citizens groups from Halton have been granted an additional \$15,000 each in intervenor funding for appearing before Joint Board hearings under the Consolidated Hearings Act, Barbara Sullivan, MPP for Halton Centre, announced today on behalf of Environment Minister Jim Bradley.

Board hearings began in 1987 following the Region of Halton's proposal to build a landfill site to be located either in Milton or in Burlington. An environmental assessment of the proposal is now before the Joint Board for approval.

Grant recipients are the West Burlington Citizen's Group and the Milton Area Citizen's Coalition who have been appearing before the Board since 1987. Both groups have also shared \$30,000 in intervenor funding previously awarded in 1987.

Also appearing before the Board are representatives from the Ministry of the Environment, and delegates from the town of Milton, the city of Burlington and others.

The hearings began in May 1987 and are expected to conclude this summer.
