REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON RECEIVES ENVIRONMENT MINISTRY WASTE MANAGEMENT GRANT TOTALLING \$1,800,000

The Regional Municipality of Halton will receive grants totalling \$1,800,000 to help pay for waste management work, Environment Minister Jim Bradley announced today.

Halton will be provided with \$700,000 for work on its comprehensive Waste Management Master Plan -- a long-range waste management planning study intended to meet the requirements of the Environmental Assessment Act.

As well, Halton will receive more than \$1 million for hearing, approval and design costs of landfill facilities.

The grants were made under the ministry's Comprehensive Funding Program for waste management, which was announced in June, 1987 to provide financial assistance to municipalities for waste management activities. These activities include treatment and disposal facilities and initiatives involving reduction, reuse, recycling and recovery of waste, collectively known as the 4R's program.
