In order to have enough time for the preparation, printing and distribution of the Winter and Spring newsletters, Annual Meeting Call for Nominations, Invitation Letter and Program Brochure, Slate of Nominations, Meeting Procedure Rules and the Annual Report, I would suggest the following timeline:

January 25	Information regarding Call for Nominations submitted to GLU office
February 1	Deadline for Winter newsletter articles
February 3	90-day Bylaws deadline for informing members of positions scheduled to be elected and any vacancies
February 9 - 12	RAP Workshop sponsored by GLU
February 15 - March 7	Intense work period on Winter newsletter
February 16	Information, articles and/or suggestions for the Annual Report; Annual Meeting program details, etc. submitted to GLU office.
March 1	Invoices sent to organizational members with reminder that dues must be paid before May 6.
March 7	All Annual Meeting printed material delivered to the printer; two weeks allowed for mass production.
March 10	Mailing of Winter newsletter
March 21	45-day Bylaws deadline for informing members of Annual Meeting AND Slate of Nominations with any vacancies. This usually includes the printed invitation letter, the program brochure, registration forms, meeting rules, etc.
March 24 - 25	GLU Board Meeting
