U.N. Launches Coral Reefs Project

NAIROBI, Kenya (AP) -- The U.N. environment agency launched a multimillion dollar project Monday to help preserve the world's coral reefs, up to 60 percent of which are at risk -- primarily from human activity, officials said. (www.un.org)

"Washington, D.C., March 8, 2001-For the first time, small-scale coffee farmers in Chiapas, Mexico will receive low-interest loans through a \$400,000 fund established by Conservation International and EcoLogic Enterprise Ventures, Inc., with a guarantee provided by Starbucks Coffee Company (Nasdaq: SBUX). The fund, named Eterno-Verde, or Evergreen, will further promote environmentally friendly coffee growing practices and conservation among the communities that surround the El Triunfo Biosphere Reserve in Chiapas."
