I'm replying just to you now since I think Tania is just trying to make sure CELA can be part of this debate. The focus on which communities have acted is only part of the picture. See the following link for a recent list. Green Venture is tracking this moving target and appears to be doing a great job.

Note however that you will be in a forum that is dominated or at least extremely well padded with the Landscapers, golfers, etc. who are part of the industry lobby against by-laws. These audiences, if my experience at Caledon is any indication, need a presentation that describes what happened in the Hudson SCC decision, what is actually in the Hudson (and similar) by-laws and especially the Municipal Act analysis. If you don't provide same, it won't be part of the discussion, at all, which is very surprising, at least I found it so in Caledon.

I also provide the information in the context of our children's health work and as an argument (as the SCC did) for precautionary action. I've done several presentations on all of this using a set of overheads that I have continuously updated and will be updating for the presentation in Perth. I think you can and should go further in the Waterloo presentation beyond the Green Venture survey info and get into the above. Emphasis will be different given their specific request but I expect it is worth touching on these areas and/or being ready for each. I'll be working on updating the presentation next week. For now, I've attached what I think is the most recent version of the PPT presentation for your information. I've also attach a transcript, that is also a bit dated, from one of the presentations. Between the two of these, I hope you can put together your own presentation fairly quickly. We also need to deal with the Municipal Act mythology - again. Let's talk about this next week.
