ALDERSHOT AT NORTH SERVICE ROAD, SITUATE BETWEEN
KING ROAD AND WATERLOO ROAD.

ATTENTION MR. CHAIRMAN:-

HOW CAN A GARBAGE DUMP SITUATED ON A SIDE OF A HILL
WITH A NATURAL WATER COURSE PLUS TWO CREEKS, ONE
ON EITHER SIDE OF THE SAID DUMP, PLUS SUBSOIL
COMPOSED MAINLY OF FRACTURED SHALE SUBSOIL.
ALL SLANTING TOWARD THE BURLINGTON RIVER AND
LAKE OTRAIO AND ROUGHLY TWO MILES DISTANT.
THIS CERTAINLY IS NOT A SUITABLE LANDFILL SITE !!!

ENVIRONMENTAL CONTAINMENT OF LEACHATE AND ALL SORTS OF
GASES HAS A VERY LIMITED STABILITY AND THESE
ADEQUATE TO A VERY COSTLY MAINTENANCE EFFORT.
THIS CERTAINLY IS NOT A SUITABLE LANDFILL SITE !!!

WHEN YOU LOOK AT THE MAP OF HAROLD REGION - PRESENT
DUMP IS SITUATED IN THE EXTREME LOWER SOUTH WEST
CORNER. THIS CERTAINLY INCREASES HAULAGE COSTS
PLUS ROAD DUST AND TRUCK NOISE.
THIS CERTAINLY IS NOT A SUITABLE LANDFILL SITE !!!

MAY 19/84 WORK SUPPOSED TO HAVE BEEN A SITE VISIT FOR
PUBLIC AS WELL AS THE "BOARD" AND "LEGAL COUNCIL"
ALL AS USUALLY EXPRESSED BY MR. CHAIRMAN OF
MAY 19/84 AT THE END OF REGULAR SITTING ON
THEY DATE.
