

GREAT LAKES UNITED ANNUAL MEETING

PROPOSED RULES

1. Admission to the Meeting shall be limited to those paying the registration fee and to invited members of the press.
2. Each delegate who wishes to speak will first state the delegate's name and, if appropriate, the organization which the delegate represents. Each delegate will use the public address system when speaking to the meeting.
3. No delegate shall speak twice to one particular motion until all delegates have had an opportunity to speak, or unless requested by the Chair.
4. The Credentials Committee reserves the power and discretion to accredit or discredit a delegate in conformance with the by-laws and to appoint a substitute for a delegate once the Meeting has begun.
5. Motions
 - a. Presentation. The original motion and supporting reasons shall be limited to five minutes.
 - b. A seconding motion and speeches shall be limited to three minutes.
6. Motions to adopt policies and/or positions as Great Lakes United Conservation Policy shall be signed by the maker and submitted in writing to the Chair prior to presentation to the membership.
7. Amendments: An amendment to a motion must relate to the subject of the main motion and must neither greatly enlarge nor change the intent of the main motion. The Chair will not accept an amendment which he/she does not consider to be germane.
8. Disputes concerning meeting procedure shall be resolved by the Chair in consultation with the Rules Committee, the Parliamentarian, and in conformance with Great Lakes United by-laws.
