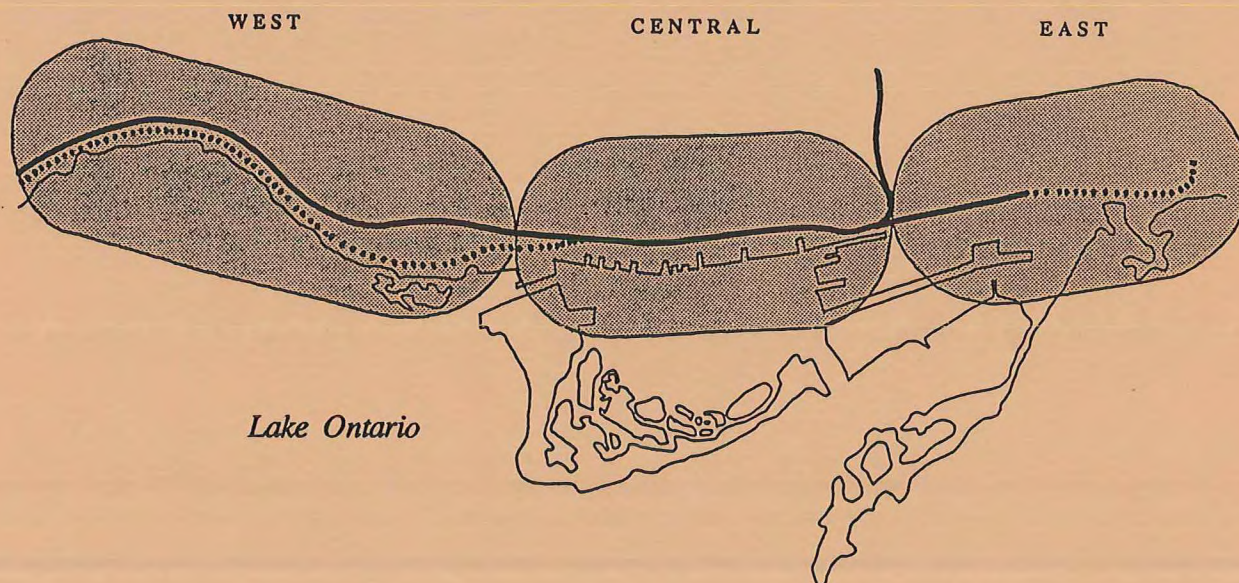

The Gardiner Lakeshore Task Force was established by Toronto City Council as a coordinating body to discuss and formulate proposals about how the Gardiner Expressway and Lake Shore Boulevard might be more adequately integrated into the fabric of the City.

The Task Force commissioned a study to examine a broad range of urban design and planning issues including: built form and massing; appropriate land uses in and adjacent to the corridor; parks and open space matters; pedestrian crossing of the corridor; and visual experience.

The principal goal of the study was to develop a long range civic design strategy and urban design guidelines which when implemented in parallel with the physical rehabilitation of the Gardiner Lakeshore Corridor will help to transform the Gardiner Expressway and Lake Shore Boulevard into a positive element of Toronto's waterfront.

The consultant's study includes ideas which:

- rejoin the city to the waterfront by reducing the barrier effect of the corridor
- improve north/south access through the corridor
- facelift the corridor through street improvements and landscaping
- create entrances to the city at the Humber River Bridge, the Don River and Queen/Woodbine
- increase parkland at Sunnyside Beach
- link Parkdale to the Lakeshore by decking over the Gardiner
- explore development opportunities at Bathurst, York, the lower Don and Greenwood racetrack
