As a member of the public and a retired Health Physicist for the WWMF, I fully support the location of the proposed DGR facility. I support the concept of the facility as the waste that is currently stored at the WWMF above ground should in fact be placed in a permanent repository and I fully support the key elements that provide confidence in the safety of the DGR and protection of the public.

As a retired Health Physicist for the WWMF I firmly believe the key elements as listed in the DGR environmental analysis and safety case have been fully investigated and provide adequate barriers to both the public and the environment.

The concept of the DGR will provide an equivalent or better way of managing the low and intermediate level waste in the long term and mitigate the potential for more above ground storage.

Based on my previous work experience with the WWMF, I agree with the proposed location of the DGR at the current WWMF, due to the long history of excellent environmental stewardship and safety record.
